


Outdated MoU's which were successfully developed to form a competitive market in Ukraine 2019-2020 do not reflect the reality and it recommended to renew the MoU













History vs reality – why is a change needed?

- SEEGAS Trans-regional Memorandum of Understanding signed during the summer 2021 which established Joint-Steering Committee, and the first official physical meeting took place in Vienna in September 2021
- Three reports were published which provide an analysis on the gas exchange, clearing and gas transmission infrastructure
- The project scope was finalized with a regional clearing analysis
- Today the MoU does not reflect the actual realities of the gas market and is not inclusive











Technical Market standards play a role for security of supply and interconnectivity of gas markets



- As of today, we see a technical split between the regions
- The gas spot market of the EEX group is cleared and settled through the SMSSsystem developed by Ponton in 2008
- To ensure compatibility with ECC's SMSS system a cooperation with Ponton is recommended
- Through a joint project the update of the old software and harmonization in the region could be achieved --> CCCs - ESP
